Impact Report

July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020

Housing and related services for families experiencing or with a history of homelessness: parenting education, employment services, behavioral health, activities.

- 187 families served.
- 380 children housed.
- 27 job placements.

Community Building Programs in West Philadelphia Commercial Corridor, Community Resources, Arts & Culture, Digital Inclusion, Food Relief, Zoning Resources

- 152,592 boxes of groceries distributed – tenfold more than in a normal year.
- Engaged 6,949 residents with resources, events, arts & culture programs, workshops.
- Distributed \$454,448 in rent and utility emergency assistance to 285 households.
- Stopped 100 evictions.

Early Childhood Education providing educational support to parents and caregivers, early childhood learning centers, and housing providers.

- 2,919 caregivers of children from birth to eight years old accessed online learning activities.
- 13,886 books distributed.
- Provided 15 shelters with access to high quality early childhood education for resident parents and caregivers.
