### Impact Report

July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021

**Housing** and related services for families experiencing or with a history of homelessness: parenting education, employment services, behavioral health, activities.

- 164 families served.
- 267 children housed.
- 29 job placements.

**Community Building Programs in West Philadelphia** Commercial Corridor, Community Resources, Arts & Culture, Digital Inclusion, Food Relief, Zoning Resources

- 71,214 boxes of groceries distributed – 7 times more than in a normal year.
- Engaged 2,598 residents with resources, events, arts & culture programs, workshops.
- Distributed \$454,448 in rent and utility emergency assistance to 285 households
- Stopped 100 evictions.

**Early Childhood Education** providing educational support to parents and caregivers, early childhood learning centers, and housing providers.

- Helped 76 caregivers of children from birth to eight years old access high quality early childhood education and literacy activities.
- 8,190 books distributed.
- Provided 24 shelters with access to high quality early childhood education for resident parents and caregivers.
